The original focus of the council was to provide the infrastructure for future public art.

- Preparing guidelines to those wanting to erect sculptures, water features or murals.
- How to apply for permits, what permits were needed and who they needed to talk to

This was quite a learning experience for everyone as it was something new for the city as well as the Public Art Council.
