

The Adventures of Ewing Young

Guest Speaker: Doug Root, Co-founder, Ewing Young Distillery

Doug Root will explain how events in Ewing Young's life led to the American settlements in The Oregon Country and how and why the Newberg area became the hub of the 'modern' history of the area beginning in 1843. He will note the key events and 'the words that changed history' in The Oregon Country and indeed across the United States. The adventures and exploits of Ewing Young are filled with real adventure, danger, and his being a true scoundrel.

Doug's storytelling-based talk describes Ewing Young's intersections and integrations with other pioneers including people who inadvertently and overtly enabled Ewing Young's Newberg (well before it was called Newberg) distilling project that literally reshaped World history beginning in 1837.

You will also learn why it is a State of Oregon law that every February 9th is known as Ewing Young Day.
